The Oska Bright Film Festival is the world's first and only international film festival run by people with learning disabilities. Oska Bright is the only platform for learning disabled film talent in the world.

An estimated 1.5 million people in the UK have a learning disability and very few learning disabled people are able to access the creative arts. The work of Oska Bright reaches over 25,000 people!

The festival is biennial & it takes place at the Brighton Corn Exchange, with the next festival due to begin in November 2015. Year round, Oska Bright screens films to thousands of people across the UK, runs filmmaking workshops and innovative new media projects.
